She has a knack for bringing up controversial items without judgment or anger which makes her perfect for this position. Karen and her husband, Lyle are pictured-right, with their presently youngest grandchild...more on the way! From Karen:



I have been attending the Foster Care Advisory Meetings for more than 10 years, and have been on the Auxiliary Board for 4 years. I usually have a houseful of special needs children, but try to attend the Auxiliary meetings and functions to show our support. Lyle and I have been foster parents for 20 years. We have always felt truly blessed to have our four healthy children and spent many years as our children got older, fostering one infant at a time. We are still surrounded by children now, and it just seems natural to us.

After the rewards of fostering a five year old with muscular dystrophy about 14 years ago, I was hooked on caring for special needs children. Since then we have cared for many children with various physical and mental disabilities... a joy giving child with Down syndrome, a brave young cancer survivor, a beautiful little girl with Dandy Walker's Syndrome, and 15 autistic children. What a challenge they are, but it is rewarding to be able to help them come out of their little world, to learn to speak and communicate with others, and most importantly to be able to live in a family and function out there in the world.

We have shed many tears when the children have moved on, but it is a joy to see them with their happy families... who celebrate their "specialness". It is so wonderful to have had a small part in their growth and know that they will always remember how much we loved them.

Our 9 grandchildren (well #9 is on the way) love to play with Grandpa and Grandma's kids. One of our grandsons calls me the Grandma with the lotta kids. So that makes my Mom the Nottalottagrandma and me the Lottagrandma. Most of them now live in Phoenix so we travel there often with our kids. It is a joy to see them being to good and gentle with our children; helping them with their braces, pushing wheel chairs, tucking them in at night and just being a part of their lives.

Being involved with the Auxiliary has been so rewarding to all of us and we have made so very many friendships. There is no better place to be and to spend our fun times than with such good people that have so many things in common as we all work together to better the lives of foster children and the families who have chosen to care for them. It is exciting to see how the Auxiliary is growing and changing. There are a lot of very talented people offering themselves and their time to accomplish some very ambitious goals. It is a blessing to be a part of it all.

community. I am pictured here with Joanna Hussey, our Social Services Agency Representative who spent the better part of her day on August 13<sup>th</sup> working with us to get this job done.

FCAOC is really looking to the future and how we can better serve the needs of foster families. It is my pleasure to introduce Rachel Pradhan as our newest member and board member. Rachel and her husband Nirzhar, designed our web site and have graciously offered to keep it up to date for us. Make sure you say hello to her at our picnic.

Another addition to our board is Chrysty Hodson, who will be in charge of managing our furniture donations and also one of my 'unsung heroes'.

Ron just showed up out of the blue to help us one day when were unloading a truck of donations for foster families. Tom doesn't ask for any help or compensation...a former foster child....just looking for a way to help out or 'enhance' the lives of foster families. Foster Care Auxiliary of Orange County has been selected by the Los Angeles Clippers Foundation for a 2006 Grant for their 'Operation Organization' Project.

The purpose of 'Operation Organization' is to organize our thrift store and distribution center so that we will attract more volunteers and be more productive with the volunteer hours we have. We hope to do this by making our self sustaining charity which operates and pays most bills from income produced at our thrift store more productive. More productivity will result in more thrift store sales which will enable us to better serve foster families.

The Foster Care Auxiliary is a non-profit group who offers support, events, encouragement, training, scholarships and a distribution center filled with donations from the community. Foster Parent members come each month to choose among the donations that help them meet the needs of their families. The Foster Care Auxiliary is run by twelve unpaid board members who put many hours each month into making these services available to foster families. We rely on the generous donations in our community and the generosity of our volunteers.

The Foster Care Auxiliary has already started making the changes of 'Operation Organization'. (See the attached photos.) On August 13, over 116 hours were spent by 29 volunteers to install new shelves in the stock area of our Distribution Center. In a short five hours we emptied the stock area and organized and labeled everything while new shelves were installed. Then the organized and labeled boxes were put neatly on our new shelves. This will make the job of stocking the distribution center and finding the donations needed so much easier. 
